Prof. Dr. CHEN Weizuo obtained his PhD at Wuhan University in China (Doctor of Laws) and Saarland University in Germany (Doktor des Rechts). His main research areas are Private International Law, Comparative Law and German Civil Law. He has published extensively on these topics, including international journal articles in Chinese, German, French and English, translations of articles and foreign or international legal documents as well as contributions to works on related topics. Next to his position at Tsinghua University, Professor Chen is Visiting Professor at the Faculté Internationale de Droit Comparé in Strasbourg, France, in charge of a course 'Introduction au Droit Chinois'. He is Member of the Executive Council of the Chinese Society of Private International Law; Arbitrator at the Weihai Arbitration Commission; and he will teach a special course in French entitled 'La nouvelle codification du droit international privé chinois' at the Hague Academy of International Law.
