The European Union in International Relations: Legal Aspects

The European Union in International Relations: Legal Aspects

In 6 sessions of 3 hours some of the most experienced legal practitioners from EU institutions will cover a number of practical legal issues regarding the European Union in international relations. The sessions will cover both issues of public international law, the law of international organizations and EU law in the EU's multilateral and bilateral external relations.



Issues dealt with will include (i) aspects of **treaty-making**, with special emphasis on the impact of the Lisbon Treaty and “do’s and don’ts” in negotiating and enforcing treaty clauses; (ii) the status

and practice of the EU in the **United Nations** and in the **World Trade Organization**; and (iii) the application of international law in the EU legal order and in the area of Common Security and Defense Policy (CSDP).

Each session is prepared through a “reading assignment” offered by the Visiting Lecturer.

This series is part of a select number of clinics offered to LL.M.students of K.U.Leuven and open to a select number of professionals.
